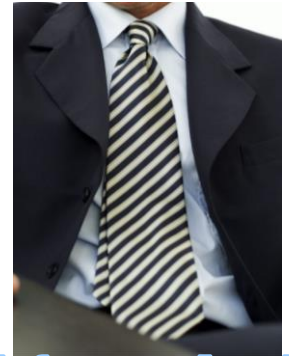

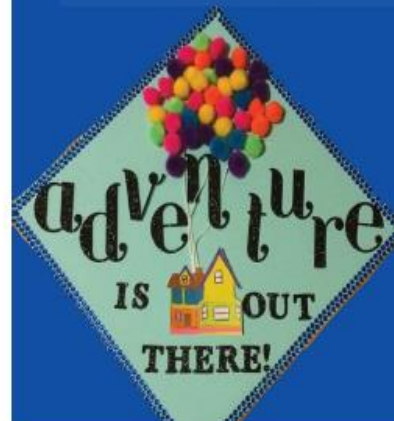

## Difference Makers will:

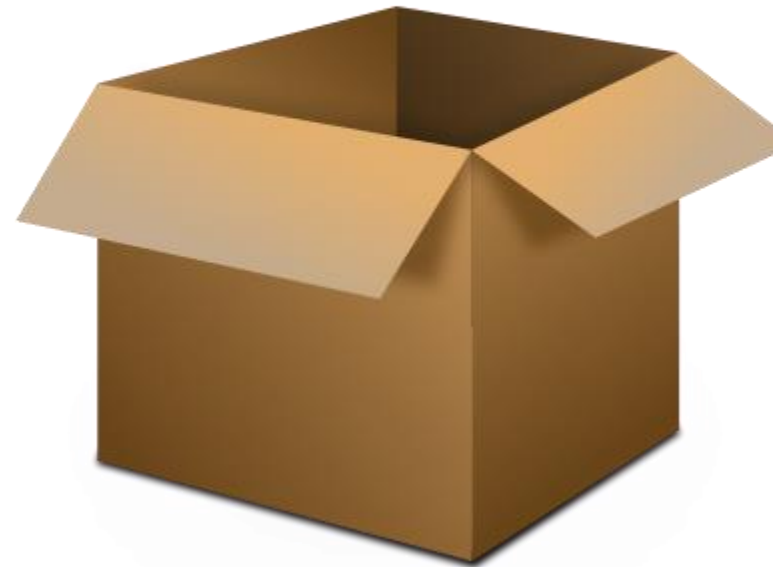
- Receive a special invitation to attend graduation, and sit in a designated Difference Maker area, to honor their accomplishments

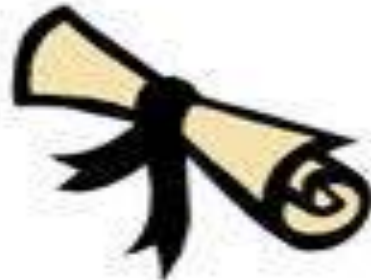
**If you are willing to leave your gown behind for a future student in need, please drop it in the box near diploma pick-up outside the Natatorium immediately following graduation.**

# **2025 Graduation Contract**

To: WHS 2025 Graduating Seniors



**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING AND ACKNOWLEDGE AGREEMENT BELOW.**

***The Graduation ceremony will be conducted according to the following guidelines:***

- Attire: Dress, skirt, pants suit or shirt with collar and tie, dress pants. No jeans or shorts. Dress shoes or sandals. No sneakers. Low heels.
- All students will wear a graduation gown (supplied) completely zippered and a graduation cap with a tassel. Absolutely nothing may be worn on the gown. It has been approved by WHS Administration that students in the Class of 2025 may decorate their caps this year for graduation. Graduates agree to abide by the expectations as outlined previously for cap decorations.
- By 5:00 p.m., students will report to the Auditorium. Students will be checked for business casual dress as outlined above.
- When lining up and when sitting on the field, students are arranged in a specific order which conforms to the graduation line-up. No student will make changes to this order.
- Any student who exhibits evidence of the use or possession of any unauthorized substance or possession of any unauthorized item will be removed immediately from the ceremony.
- Any student who exhibits any other inappropriate behavior that warrants dismissal will be escorted from the ceremony. The student and parent(s) will have to make an appointment with high school administration to receive the student's diploma.

**Wristbands are required!**

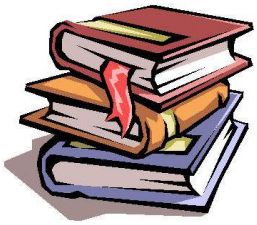
10 wristbands will be given for graduation on the field.

Pay by May 1 for 4YR college-bound students. If you plan to accept financial aid award offers, you should also follow any required steps given to you by your university.

- **Waitlists:**

Even if you have chosen to stay on a waitlist, you should deposit elsewhere by May 1. Waitlist offers are likely to come later in May or June.

# Senior Reminders



- **Update Your Outcomes in Scoir:**

Before the end of the year, you should be entering all of your admissions decisions in Scoir and marking which school will be the one where you plan to enroll. Colleges must be moved to the Applied tab before you can note outcomes. This also helps future Wiss students look at data.

- **Final Transcripts:**

Final transcripts are automatically sent to the college that you indicate in Scoir immediately after graduation. This should be the school that you plan to enroll at in the Fall 2025 semester. You do NOT need to request this transcript.
